Ribe

Køreturen går tværs over Sydjylland og følger på store dele Kongeåen. Kammerslusen og Ribe by er mål for turen. Sidste del af turen går på nordsiden af Kolding Fjord.

The tour goes across the peninsula Jylland and largely follows the Kongeå River.
The Kammerslusen and Ribe city are the destinations of the tour. The last part of the trip goes on the north side of Kolding Fiord.

Kl. 9.00 - 09.30

Start fra parkeringspladsen ved Hindsgavl slot. Start from the parking lot at Hindsgavl castle

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The MG EEOTY tour from Hindsgavl to Ribe.

Across the peninsula JYLLAND from east to west, from LILLEBÆLT to the WADDEN SEA - and back again.

First we cross the old bridge LILLEBÆLTSBROEN (1935) and go on to Kolding on the old MAIN ROAD 1, from Copenhagen to Esbjerg. We'll follow the mainroad, now 161, through Kolding, then 191 and 32.

You'll hardly notice, but at distance between Kolding and Ribe - more exact 23 km from Skodborg to Villebøl - we drive along the KONGEÅ (Kings River), which formed the border between Denmark and Prussia (Germany) in the years from 1864 to 1920.

Midway between Skodborg and Villebøl, we turn right to Åtte Bjerge. On your LH side you can see the bridge over the KONGEÅ - on of the danish / german border passings.

Stop at a large, green parking space for a break at Åtte Bjerge - ½ hour. You can climb the 'mountain' with the highest point of 59 m and an excellent view over the valley with the Kongeåen running at the bottom.

We go on at narrow roads near the river and cross it at Villebøl Kro/Camping, which was a border post. From that point the border continued on further south in a large arc south of Ribe, but KONGEÅEN continues west to the Wadden Sea/North Sea. And so do we!The road BÆKVEJ is following the river through Hjortlund to Gredstedbro and on to Kongeådal, where we'll cross the river once again.

We now drive out into the flat country - the marsh - which is protected by the sea dyke since about 1910. In the past, storm surges could reach all the way in and flood Ribe. Cross the light bridge at the KAMMERSLUSE - chamber lock. You have now reached and the Restaurant Kammerslusen where lunch will be served at 12. Before lunch we will enter the dike to have a view over the the Watten Sea and the islands of Mandø (left) and Fanø (in front) with Esbjerg on RH. The lock opens at low tide and closes automatically to high tide, the difference is normally up to 1,80 m.

Enjoy your meal - we continue to Ribe at 1 pm.

When turning right onto Ringvejen/Route 11/Route 24 a new layout is under construction, but you can pass - follow the planner to the P at HOVEDENGEN next to Danhostel Sct. Peders Gade 16.

We go on by foot to the old main/shopping street of Ribe, which runs across 2 islands in the middle of the stream Ribe Å. Passing a couple of backyards we walk to the traffic hub 'the DUCK-ISLAND' - also in the middle of the stream. If you go left by the wooden bridge you come to the banks of the river where the Vikings settled in the years 7-900. They left again some 1100 years ago, so we go right to the Sct. Catharinæ Plads/MUNKETORVET (the Monks Square). Sct. Catharinæ Church and Monastery (behind) was founded by Dominican monks around 1228 and, together with the Ribe Cathedral, are the only remaining buildings of 15 churches in Ribe before the Reformation in 1536. We go right in SORTEBRØDREGADE (Black Brothers) to the main street, to the right and stop at the bridge at SKIBBROEN - the habour of Ribe. You can see you cars on the meadow from here. With the tourist guide in your hand you can go to the icecream-shop on the corner, to pubs, cafe's, restaurants, shops or whatever you want to. From SKIBBROEN 3 SLIPPE'r leads you to FISKERGADE and on to GRØNNEGADE and PRÆSTEGADE. I you go left in any of the old streets you can't miss the Ribe Cathedral. Take a walk around the church and go in, if you have time.

Othervice, we have planned to leave Ribe again at 15.15 pm, so go to your cars in time.

Toilets are next to the parking.

The trip from Ribe to Jels Voldsted is more or less, just the shortest route from one place to another. It is driving through typical Danish agricultural areas.

Jels Voldsted is located in a place where in the Middle Ages there was a large impassable forest, Farrisskoven. It is believed that the site of the violence and its former castle may have been the center of a considerable fur trade. There were plenty of skins in the forests, and the nearby Hærvejen ensured good logistics. It is considered probable that the castle burned down in approx. 1420s, and not rebuilt since.

Jels Voldsted is believed to have been a castle or fortress, and according to the conditions of the time, had a considerable size. It's about. 130 m between the northern and southern shielding, the embankment is approx. 300 m long, and encompasses an area of 160 by 100 m.


In the period from 1864 to 1920, the area where Jels Voldsted is located was part of the Prussian kingdom, i.e. German. In the local area and north of the Kongeå grænsen/-border, national forces worked to establish a Danish-minded gathering place on the area at Jels Voldsted. A stakeholder company was formed and bought the land in 1919 and converted it into a meeting place. The first meeting was held on Constitution Day 1920. A pavilion was built as a restaurant. In the first years, several thousand people gathered to celebrate, for example, Constitution Day. The need for a common meeting place across the old border meant that in 1923 a hall was built for the restaurant. Because the people behind had roots in the very religious Indre Mission (Inner Mission), no alcohol was served at the resaurant. Both restaurant and the hall are still in use. The area at Jels Voldsted was for many years a favorite excursion spot.

After the break we drive north and soon we will pass the Kongeåen and the old border again for a last time on this trip. The town of Vamdrup is passed. Later we drive through the Ice Age tunnel valley Hylkedal into the town of Kolding. Outside of Kolding, we follow the north side of Kolding Fjord, pass the old Lillebæltsbro again, drive through the animal park to Hindsgavl Castle. And that was the trip!



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
